7 HOLIDAY TRASH PICKUP SCHEDULE

When the Holiday falls on a regular trash day, there will be no pickup services (Monday, Jan 15th MLK Day and Monday, February 19th Presidents Day) The extra trash will be removed on the next regularly scheduled pick-up day

For residents who can't wait for garbage pick-up to occur after a holiday, a household may opt to bring garbage to the Lake County Landfill located at 13130 County Landfill Road (County Road 561), Tavares. Disposal of household trash is FREE for any city resident with a valid ID. Call ahead for hours of operation 352-343-3776 (this is not a city facility).
